

Mrs. Hubert Bailey Dutel, wife of John J. Dutel, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Dutel, died Friday at West Palm Beach, Fl. She was the daughter of H. C. Bailey and Etta Johnson Bailey. They married in New Orleans on 10-24-1925. Mrs. Dutel dying not long after the birth and death of her infant on 5-21. Interment was in the Ellis cemetery. Survivors are her husband, father, 1 brother, Jas. F. Bailey of New Augusta, Ms., 2 sisters, Mrs. B.P. Montagriff of Denver, Col., and Mrs. B.B. O'Mara of Jackson, Ms.
