Estate of Thomas Bailey Dec'd

This day came Mary Bailey administrator of the estate of said deceased and filed in Court her account and vouchers for a partial settlement of the administration of the said estate. It is therefore ordered by the Court that said settlement go before hearing at a term of this court to be held on the second Monday of May next & that notice of the time & place of said settlement begin by publication in the Linden Jeffersonian once a week for three successive weeks and that ___?___ & Gholson be appointed Gdn Ad Litem to defend the interest of the minor heirs of said estate.

It is therefore ordered that said application be granted and that Thomas Morgan, Arch ___?___, James Tate, J. Ford & William S. Bailey be appointed commissioners to make said division and that an order issued to them accordingly. And it is further ordered the said commissioners make their report at the December Term of this Court next.
