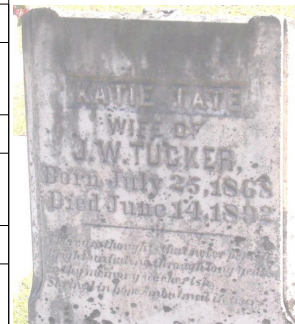

Funeral arrangements are incomplete pending the arrival of relatives. The body is at Sechrest Funeral Home, Lexington Avenus.

Mr. Tucker was born June 20, 1891 in Thomasville, Ala., a son of James and Kate Tate Tucker. He was a resident of the Elwood Hotel before entering Maryfield Nursing Home and had lived in High Point 40 year. He owned and operated Peerless Plywood Company, before retiring in 1953. He was a member of Elks Lodge 1153 and was a Mason and a Shriner. Surviving are two daughters, Miss Hazel Tucker and Mrs. O.A. Holmedal, both of Ft. Lauderdale, Fla.; and three grandchildren; and one sister, Miss Annalee Tucker of Thomasville, Ala.
Funeral will be held at 2:00 p.m. Sunday in Sechrest Chapel by Rev. Cecil E. Heyworth. Entombment will be in Guilford Memorial Park Masoleum. The body will remain at Sechrest Funeral Home, Lexington Avenue.
